

Adobe Flash is built into Google Chrome. For security reasons, Flash is not enabled by default. Some sites may produce a dialog box asking to enable Flash player for embedded content (or control-click on the embedded content to get the dialog box). Other websites are built with Flash and need to be enabled going through the Chrome settings.


1. Open Google Chrome and type chrome://settings/content in the address bar




2. Scroll down the list to Flash. Click on the right-pointing arrow.



3. It is recommended to leave the setting "Ask First" on. Instead, click on ADD to add the individual website you wish to run Flash. Type in the entire URL of the site. (Example: http://www.webassign.net)





Click on ADD after typing the address.

Then, reload the Flash-based page.
