Please note that students are being asked to bring a change of clothes to BA for the Post Prom event along with hangers & bags for dresses and tuxes when they arrive for Grand March. Items will be placed in a labeled bag provided by the Post Prom Committee and left in the locker room.

All students attending Post Prom and their parents should understand that this is a privately conducted Post Prom event. Anyone attending must agree to and follow all rules and protocol as designated by the Post-Prom Committee of junior parents. Any inappropriate actions or violations of rules at the Post Prom event will result in the student's parent(s) being notified to come pick up their child from the event.

If a child wishes to leave the event prior to 4:00 A.M., the parent(s) will be notified, and the student will not be allowed to re-enter Bethlehem Academy.

Any non-BA student who accompanies a BA student to Post Prom following their attendance at Prom must also turn in this form. **No student will be allowed to go to Post Prom if this form is not turned in to the office by Friday**, **April 28**, **2023**.

Anyone not abiding by the rules and protocols for this event will not be allowed to continue to participate in the Post Prom event, and a parent will be contacted. Event chaperones will try to take reasonable measures to keep all attendees safe. No alcohol, drugs, or smoking of any substances (including vaping) will be tolerated at this event. We will be checking students as they enter and may possibly have a random check during the event if a situation arises that warrants it. No food or drink may be brought into the event. Bags measuring 6"x4"x2" may be brought into the event and will be required to be checked. Please note that the bags students left in the lockers rooms at Grand March will remain in the locker rooms for the duration of the Post Prom event and students will not be allowed access into the locker room until the event has ended at 4:00 A.M..
