COVID-19 Self-Screening

Staff and visitors must participate in a daily COVID-19 self-screening (series of questions). When Hybrid or In-Person learning models are in place, parents/guardian are to perform a daily COVID-19 check on their student(s) to determine if their child can attend school. *Please refer to the following checklist:*

COVID-19 Student Daily Return to School Checklist**

	exhibiting <i>any one</i> of the following symptoms associated with COVID-19:
	New onset cough and/or worsening cough
	Difficulty breathing
	New loss of taste or smell
	Fever (100.4 or higher)
	 Sibling being sent home with COVID-19 symptoms
	Or, my student is not experiencing <i>any two</i> of the following less common symptoms:
	Sore throat
	Nausea
	 Vomiting
	Diarrhea
	Muscle pain/body aches
	Excessive fatigue
	New onset of severe headache
	New onset nasal congestion or runny nose
	• Chills
	My student has not been in close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer) with anyone in the last 14 days who has been quarantined or isolated due to COVID-19.
	My student has not been advised by any medical provider or health authority that he/she may have been exposed to COVID-19.
	There is currently no one in my home experiencing COVID-19 related symptoms or waiting for COVID-19 test results. (<i>If yes, all members of the household must stay home.</i>)
	I understand that in the case that I am notified that my student may have been exposed to COVID-19 or starts to exhibit any of the symptoms above while at school, I will immediately pick up my student when contacted by school administration.
	Per the governor's executive order, I understand that my students (Kindergarten through 12 th Grade) are required to wear a face covering over the nose and mouth.
