

Dear parents and guardians of BA Students:

I am reaching out today to inform you that registration for the 21-22 school year is upon us! I have been presenting registration information to High School students this week (February 22-23rd) and will be joining middle school classrooms next week (March 1-3).

These presentations include student graduation requirements, course selection information, connections to future plans, and AP, CIS, and PSEO information for incoming juniors and seniors. I have begun taking appointments with individual students this week and next to assist them in planning for their next year with us here at BA.

The registration timeline is as follows:

- February 23rd-24th: Registration information presented to high school students
- March 1st-3rd: Registration information presented to middle school students
- **Wednesday, March 3: All HS Registration planning forms due**
Course selection input to PowerSchool in HS Religion classes
- **Thursday, March 4th: Conferences and PSEO/AP/CIS information night at 6:30PM**
- **Thursday, March 11th: All students *final course selection* for 21-22 input to PowerSchool**
- March 13-21: Spring Break
