- -The cost is FREE
- -This new youth league first formed last year

6TH GRADE PLAYING OPTIONS

I'm currently talking with Ed Friesen (Bethlehem Academy's Athletic Director/Varsity Boys Basketball Coach) to see what the plan is for this year's 6th grade boys and girls.

- **B.A. Middle School Team**: Sometimes, 6th graders 'play up' and join 7th/8th graders depending on their skill level, interest, and if there aren't enough players on the B.A. middle school team. This is a Monday-Friday practice schedule with several home and away games during the weekdays.
- **Gopher League**: Otherwise, 6th graders who may not be quite ready to play on the middle school team at B.A. can play in this less-intense 'gopher league' approx. two practices per week (**purpose of this form**)

If your child is interested in playing but isn't sure they want to commit, that's okay! (and is quite common). I encourage everyone to try it out - many who were nervous ended up staying and playing for several years.
