CEP stands for Concurrent Enrollment Program. This Program allows juniors and seniors to earn college credit by taking college courses at Cherry High School with their high school teachers.

## the requirements?

Students must take and pass an Accuplacer test in reading or math, depending on the course. To enroll as a junior, an overall GPA of 3.0 must be earned. To enroll as a senior, an overall GPA of 2.5 must be earned. Some CEP courses require specific prerequisite courses.
ALI courses require good academic standards.

## do to prepare?

To prepare for CEP courses, students should develop good study habits and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher in $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ grade.
