
Welcome to Infinite Campus Food Service and Online Payments!

We have switched over to Campus Food Service and Online Payments. Through the Parent Portal, you can now conveniently log on to view individual or family meal account balances, sign up to receive low balance e-mail notifications, and view daily meal purchases in real time.

Visit Foley Infinite Campus Parent Portal to begin viewing Food Service account information.

Viewing Current Lunch Balance:

- Select Food Service
- Window opens to Food Service
- Family account information is present
- To view transactions for individual student,
 - Select student name from Show transactions for dropdown
 - Select month or date range
 - Select Go



You also have the convenience of using Campus Online Payments. This reliable and secure payment processing solution allows you to submit food service deposits 24/7 via the Portal. Payments can be made for one child or the entire household.

Payment Setup:

- Select payments
- Enter amount in box under payment and continue (estimate of the monthly cost will be provided for informational purposes only)
- Add a method of payment and save
 - If choosing checking or savings; routing and account number will be required
 - If choosing credit card; card number, expiration date and name of cardholder will be required
- Save again to confirm
- Click "Back to Payments"
- Click "Continue" to proceed with payment
- Click "Make payment" to finalize payment
- You will have the option to print a receipt and enter an email address to receive confirmation



In addition, Campus Food Service works with the Campus Mobile Portal app and is accessible at your fingertips. With the app, you can view meal account balances for one or multiple children. The app can be downloaded for free from iTunes, Google Play or Amazon, depending on your device.
