#### How does my member ID card work?

On the front of your ID card are both the HealthPartners and Cigna logos. These logos let the doctor's office staff know that HealthPartners works with Cigna to give you, a HealthPartners member, access to in-network care throughout the United States, so you're covered nationwide.
