532.1 PEACE OFFICERS' AUTHORITY TO REMOVE STUDENTS FROM SCHOOL GROUNDS

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to describe the circumstances under which peace officers may remove a student from school grounds, not withstanding Policy 532.2 describing additional specific circumstances under which peace officers can remove students with IEP's from school grounds.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

In the absence of parental consent, the principal will release students to law enforcement officials only in the following circumstances:

- 1. if a warrant is issued, or
- 2. if the officer has legal right to arrest, or
- 3. if the officer determines the student is in need of protective custody, or
- 4. if the arresting officer provides a written statement that he or she has seen the student commit a specific offense.
