A.M. Student Drop Off Reminders

Families that drop-off students in the morning should plan to use the student drop-off lane with students exiting the vehicle on the passenger side directly to the sidewalk or park in the lot and walk their child(ren) to the front doors. The number of students being dropped off by parents in the morning has increased from years past. With more students being dropped off, comes an increase in traffic. Please slow down in the parking lot and plan for drop-off to take a little longer. We understand this may be inconvenient, but our primary goal is to make sure everyone is safe.

If you park and walk your child in, please be vigilant as you cross the drop-off lane. Please hold your child's hand as you cross traffic exiting the parking lot until you are on the sidewalk.

If you use the drop off lane, please be vigilant as you drive away and exit the parking lot, as some parents walk their children up to the building. Please, do not stop and let your children out of your vehicle until you are in the drop-off lane and pull forward as far as you can in the drop-off lane before allowing your children to exit the vehicle. This allows for more cars in the lane and a faster drop off for all.

Early Childhood Screening

*Required by the state for all children.

The screening is a quick and simple check of how your child is doing at the age of $3 \frac{1}{2}$ to $4 \frac{1}{2}$ years old. During the screening, your child's vision and hearing will be checked along with skills in all developmental areas. The screening is free of charge to families through the school district.


