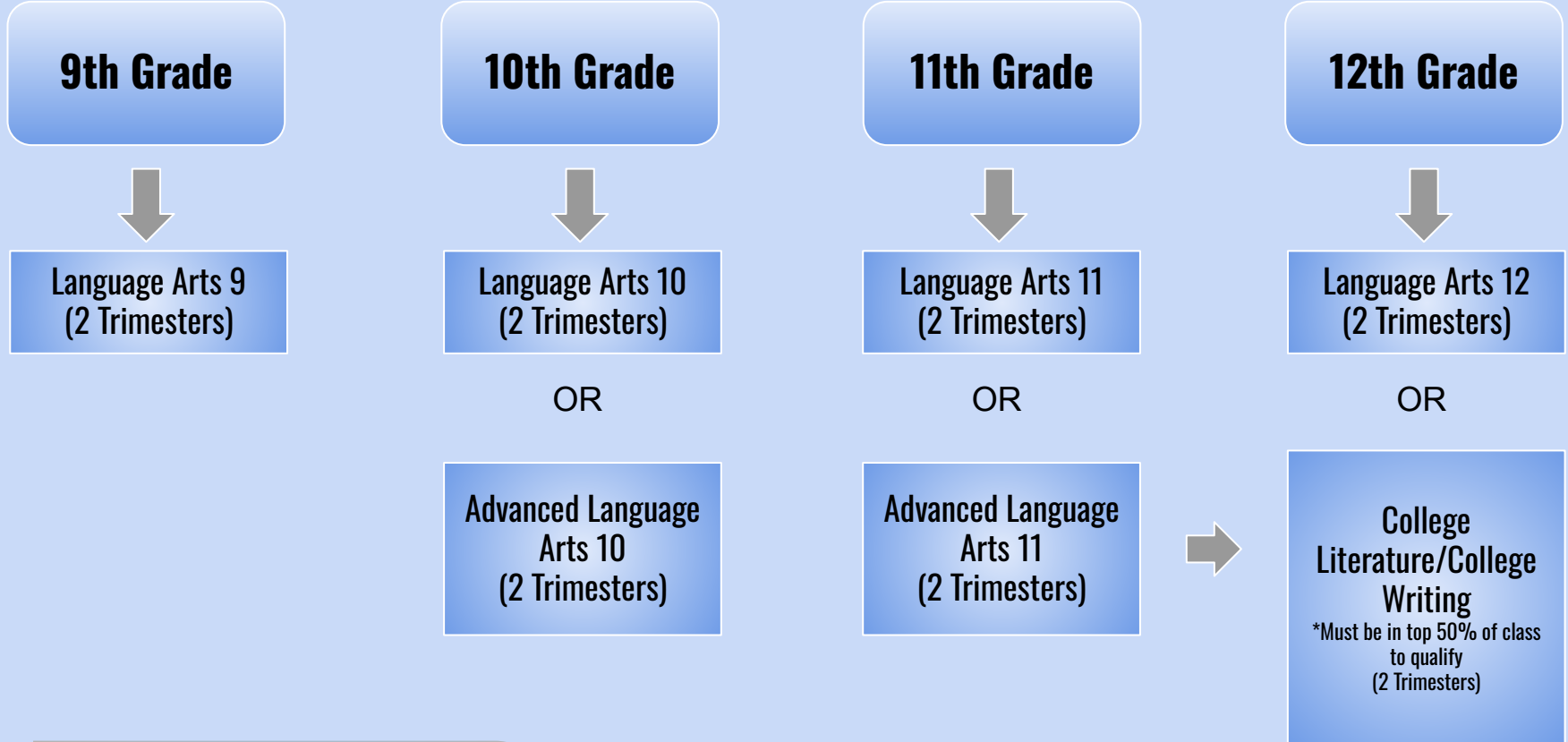

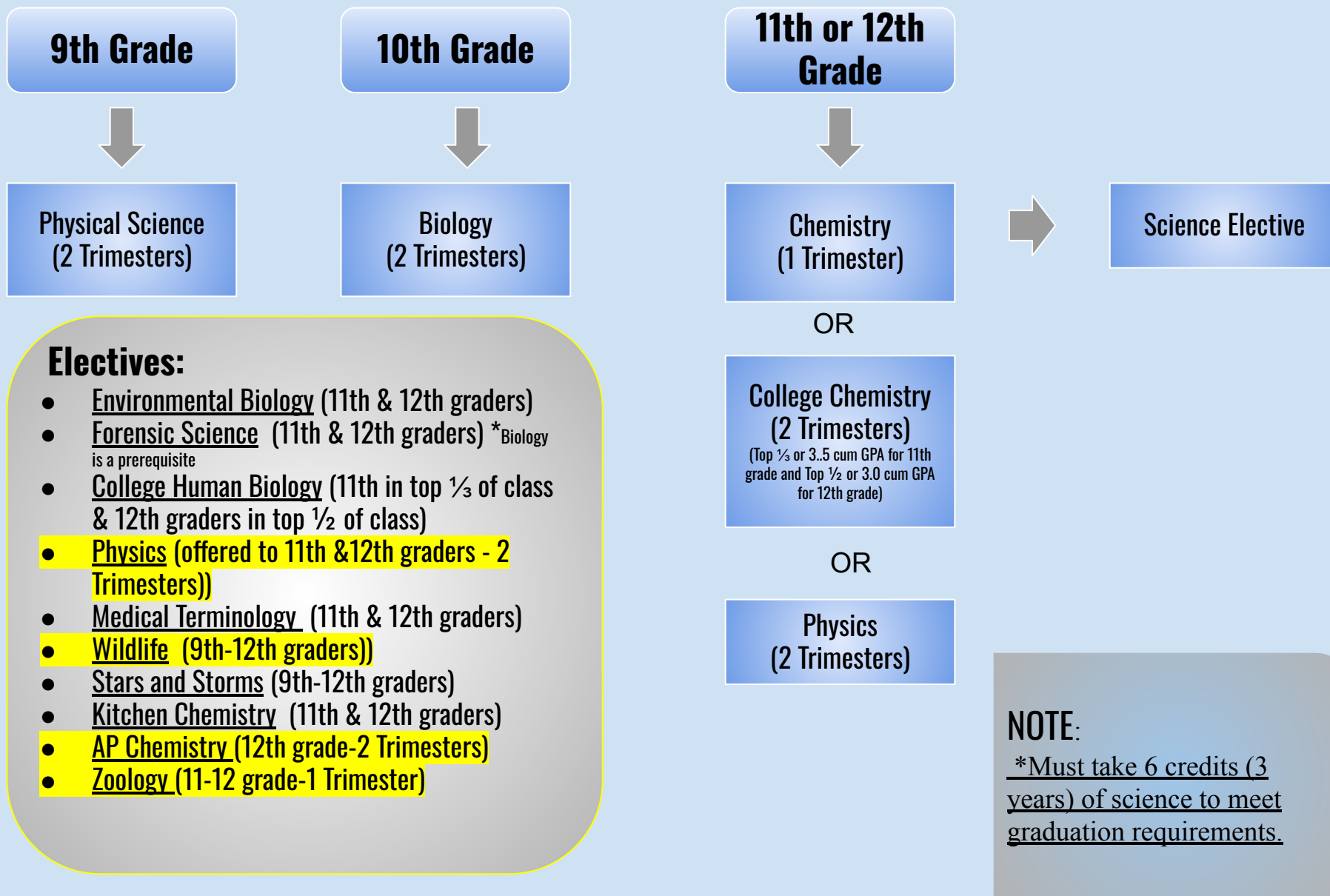

Electives:

- Target, Racquet, & Net Sports (offered to 9-12th graders)
- Team sports (offered to 9-12th graders)
- Cross Circuit (offered to 9-12th graders)
- Shape-up fitness (offered to 9-12th graders)
- Unified Sports-(offered to 9-12th graders)
- SAPQR (by season) (offered 9th-12th graders) *Lifetime activity and fitness is a prerequisite
- Aquatics/ Lifeguard Training (offered to 10-12th graders)
- Advanced Health & Performance (offered to 11-12th graders)

*Health 9 & at least one of the following: Shape-up Fitness, Cross Circuit, SAPQR.

*All electives are 1 Trimester (1 credit long)

Notes:

- Must take 1 credit of 9th grade health & 1 credit of Lifetime Activity and Fitness to graduate (2 credits total)
- After 9th grade any Physical Education & Health Classes are optional
- Courses taken in addition are considered electives
- Can repeat courses only twice. Check your transcript on Infinite Campus to make sure that you are not taking classes more than two times.

FHS Art & Music Course Sequence

Notes:

- Must take 2 credits of Art/Music
- Can choose from any art & music classes to satisfy these credits
- Anything beyond the 2 credits will be considered an elective
- For art, Intro to Art is a prerequisites for the remaining courses
- For vocal music, see course catalog for prerequisites
- For instrumental music, see course catalog for prerequisites
- New course - Guitar 2
- College Credit - Drawing and Ceramics & Sculpture Handbuilding
