To schedule a class D road test:

If age 18 or under, you must hold an instruction permit for a minimum of 180 days and meet the criteria to qualify for a road test. If age 19 or older, you must hold an instruction permit for a minimum of 90 days to qualify for a road test.

You MUST bring:

- Your social security number
- Your valid instruction permit
- Your own vehicle, on which

The Minnesota State Driver License Exam station is open on Thursdays and Fridays.

The Driver Exam hours are: 8-3:15 for Written Test and 8-4 Office Hours.

- Doors must open from inside and outside.
- Seatbelts must work properly.
- Headlights, taillights, brake lights and turn signals must work properly.
- Vehicle registration must be current (license plates and registration stickers) or the vehicle must display a 21-day permit.
- Valid proof of insurance (such as the original insurance identification card or policy) for the vehicle you are taking the test in. Photocopies or copies off the Internet are not acceptable.
- o If you are under 18 years of age, you must
- o Present a certificate of course completion (white card) to prove you have completed an approved driver education course.
- Have held an instruction permit for at least six months with no convictions for moving violations or alcohol/controlled substance violations.
- Present your Supervised Driving Log signed by your primary driving supervisor.
- Present the Supplemental Parental Curriculum completion certificate if the course was completed after you obtained your instruction permit.
- o If you are under 18 and all or part of your six months of driving experience was in a state other than Minnesota, you must provide a certified driving record from that state.
- o If you are under 18, a parent/guardian signature is required to apply for a driver's license if the test is passed. However, a parent/guardian need not be present during the road test.
- There is a \$20 test fee for a third or subsequent test (after failing first two). Payment by cash or check only; credit or debit cards are not accepted.
