The first day of school for Elementary students will be <u>Wednesday, September 6th</u>.

Please fill out the forms and bring with you to registration. Details to be taken care of include; medication forms, athletic sports fees and passes, lunch accounts, band rent, FFA dues, internet forms, iPad rental/insurance payment, Elementary scheduling of Student/Parent/Teacher interviews, bus route sign-up, etc. If you do not have access to a computer—these forms will be available at registration. You will just need to fill out that day. All FEES can be PAID AT REGISTRATION.

NEW CHANGES IN OUR BUS ROUTES: The Glenville-Emmons School District contracted out their transportation of students to and from school as well as extracurriculars last year. The company that purchased our transportation services is based in Owatonna. They also own and operate buses for the following school districts: Albert Lea Public School, Owatonna Public School, Medford Public Schools, and Blooming Prairie Public Schools. This is a family owned business and they are committed to providing efficient and safe transportation for our students. There is a form regarding transportation that needs to be filled out each year. FREE SCHOOL MEALS FOR KIDS!!:

Governor Walz signed the Free School Meals for Kids bill on Friday, March 17th, 2023. The Minnesota Department of Education is excited to implement this program for our students in Minnesota for the 2023-2024 school year. This is for breakfast/lunch. We will still offer our ala-carte items for high school students. You will be able to put money in their accounts at registration for when they purchase ala-carte items. Filling out the application is still important! Your child(ren) may qualify for other benefits like reduced fees at school. Your application may also help the school qualify for educational funds, discounts and other meal programs.

IPAD RENTAL AND INSURANCE: The rental fee/insurance coverage fee for **2023-2024 is \$75.00**. Your iPads will be available at registration to pay for and take with you. iPads will not go home with students until the fee is paid. If you opt to keep your child/children's iPad at school, they will need to turn them in at the end of each day and pick them up in the morning from the office.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS: <u>Grade 12 students</u> are required to have a booster does of meningococcal vaccine before entering 12th grade in the fall. Notices were mailed out to 12 grade students needing to get this immunization. All immunizations must be completed and verification provided to the school before the first day of school on Sept. 5th 2023. <u>Students entering grade 7</u> for 2023 2024 school year are required to have up to date immunizations. Before entering grade 7, your child should receive a Tdap shot (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) and a Meningococcal (MCV4 shot. Notices were mailed out regarding this. All immunizations must be completed and verification provided to the school before the first day of school on September5th, 2023.

INFINITE CAMPUS PORTAL: If you are not set up on Infinite Campus for checking your child's grades/progress, please contact the school for more information on this and to get your code. We will also have information on this at registration.

PARENT/STUDENT/TEACHER MEETING for K-6th grade will be held on <u>Tuesday, September 5th</u>. The times are from 10:00am-6:00pm. You can sign up for times at registration. The meeting with your child's/children's teacher will be approximately 15 minutes long. Students should bring their school supplies in on that day.
