Grand Meadow SAC: School Aged Care

Grand Meadow Kindergarten through 4th-grade students are offered after-school care from 3:00-6:00 pm. It will be located in the SAC room in the elementary dome.

After school, a snack will be served each day.

* If the school announces a weather-related early release (unscheduled), SAC will be available for one hour following the dismissal so parents can more easily make necessary arrangements for their child/children to be picked up. If school is canceled there will be no SAC.

PLEASE NOTE: This does not include scheduled early releases, on which days there will be NO after-school SAC offered. COST: \$2.75/hr.

There is an annual \$35 registration fee for new families or \$15 registration fee for returning families. Families will be billed bi-weekly for services.






J.O. Volleyball


