This is Maple River's 21^{st} conference championship in 32 years at Maple River. For the Eagles in the Gopher Conference, it was their 3^{rd} title in 8 years of competition in the league. Maple River finished the Gopher Conference season a perfect 13-0 including an impressive 25.6 scoring margin. The Eagles had just 2 of the 13 games decided by less than 20 points.
