The Maple River Boys Basketball team just completed a 30 and 4 season and won their 3rd straight Gopher Conference Crown. The Eagles defeated MVL 75-71 in the Section 2AA Championship game and advanced to the Class AA State Tournament. The Eagles received the #4 seed in the State Tournament, but fell in the first round to Minnehaha Academy 53-48. Maple River would defeat Eden Valley-Watkins 59-32 before falling to Pequot Lakes 50-43 in consolation games. Maple River led all Minnesota AA teams in scoring defense for the 2nd straight season allowing just 44.7 points per game. Maple River won their 23rd conference championship in 34 years as a school. For the Eagles, it was their 5th title in 10 years of competition in the Gopher Conference. Maple River finished the conference season with a perfect 16-0 record and by winning the West Division, they advanced to the Conference Championship game. In the Conference Championship game against Hayfield in Mapleton, the Eagles defeated the Vikings 73-70 in a double overtime thriller. Maple River dominated the conference competition outscoring their opponents 68.1 to 37.0, a whopping 31.1 scoring margin. Despite the domination, Maple River only garnered two all-conference members of the 18 selected by the conference coaches. The Eagles were led by senior captains Mason Schirmer, Hayden Niehbuhr and Will Sellers. Maple River was ranked in the top 10 of Class AA throughout the year, ending the year ranked #6 in the state. The 30 wins for the Eagles set a school record for wins in a season surpassing 29, set by 3 different Maple River teams.
