

Why is this important?



It is the Law!

- * FAPE: Free Appropriate Public Education
- * Assigned to regular courses/classes IF their needs can be met
- * May receive regular education with special education to co-teach, provide assistance, technology, and consultation
- * In separate classes ONLY if they cannot be educated satisfactorily in general education setting

Doe v. Withers

- High school history teacher refused to provide modifications promised to student in the IEP
- Student failed history exam
- Civil lawsuit was filed by the family
- * Jury trial moved forward against the history teacher
- * Student/family awarded \$15,000 payed by history teacher out of own pocket
- * Why because it was proven to willfully and blatantly not follow IEP

WHO?

It is everyone's responsibility!

You are the expert.

Educators

General Ed Teachers

Expert of your area(s) of curriculum, assignments, and assessments.

Special Ed Teachers

Expert in the area of disabilities and specialized instruction.

Student with a disability is a general education student first!

What is the difference between an accommodation and a modification?

Modifications

- Lowers rigor of learning
- Reduces standards/outcomes/expectations
- Changes grading/credits
- College bound students should not have modifications

Accommodations Level the playing field Reduce hurdles

- * Accommodations in Response
- * Accommodations in **Setting**
- Accommodations in <u>Timing/Scheduling</u>
- Behavioral Accommodations
- Para support can also be included within the accommodations.***

Program Modifications, Supports, and Adaptations in General and Special Education

The statement of adaptations needs to indicate the following:

WHAT – the specific support needed is

WHEN – the conditions that trigger the support

WHERE – the environment(s) in which the support is needed

WHO – is responsible for implementing the support

ACCOMMODATIONS, MODIFICATIONS AND SUPPORTS

MODIFICATIONS

Program Modifications, Supports and Adaptations in General and Special Education

WHAT- Student will be allowed to walk instead of run for at least half of the time required.

WHEN (The condition that triggers the support) - Due to severe asthma, when the student is required to run the mile

WHERE - during Physical Education (PE) class, either in the gym or outside WHO- as implemented by the PE teacher

Due to severe asthma, Student will be allowed walk instead of run for at least half of the time when required to run the mile during Physical Education (PE) class as implemented by the PE teacher.
