Special Transportation (03: Disabled)

<u>Special Transportation (03)</u> on the Service Page is only for Student with IEPs who need specialized transportation because they cannot ride the regular bus route with the majority of the district's students due to location of the special education program or classes, disabling conditions, or unique time / schedules of their programs for the child to benefit from his/her special education services.

If the student requires special transportation due to "disabling conditions" in which they require adaptations or accommodations (paraprofessional or nurse practitioner, quiet bus services without stimuli, etc.), or adaptations (lift bus, special vehicle, special routings, etc.) that are necessary for the student to attend his/her special education classes, the IEP must state what accommodations and adaptations are needed.

If a student requires transportation to receive services during the day for the following: PAES Lab (Kellogg & Caledonia) or Parochial students to public school to receive special education

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You **DO** use Special Transportation Code 03. **Do check Yes** on the special transportation box on the IEP service page.

Document in the PLAAFP the need for the transportation to and from these services.

An <u>Emergency Health / Transportation Information Form</u> needs to be completed for the 03 Transportation.

The Emergency Health / Transportation Information Form should be reviewed at the beginning of each year and at the annual IEP meeting to verify pick up and drop off locations, as well as parent and emergency contact information.
