Required Team Members for an IEP Meeting

- Parents/Guardians
- At least 1 Regular Education Teacher
- Special Education Teacher in the Student's disability(s) area (Both Primary and Secondary)
 - Case Manager of Student-Can be the same person as Special Education Licensed Teacher
- School District Representative (Principal, Assistant Principal, Dean of Students, etc.)
- Student must be invited when Secondary Transition is being considered and discussed

Additional Team Members:

Attendance is not required but is Best Practice

- Additional Service Providers: Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, Speech and Language Pathologist, DAPE Teacher, Deaf and Hard of Hearing, Blind Visually Impaired, Audiologist, English as a Second Language, Guidance Counselor, Social Worker, etc.
- Outside Agencies that work with Student: Mental Health Workers, PCA's, Therapists, County Caseworker
- Resident District Representative must be invited but are not required to attend

Secondary Transition Age (beginning during 9th grade or below):

- Outside Agencies: SEMCIL, Workforce Centers, Vocational Rehabilitation
