- For Initial Evaluations:
 - Send and enter ASD Parent Interview Initial and Developmental History
 - Give and enter ASD Teacher Interview
 - Do 2 new observations for ASD
 - These are stand alone observations. They cannot be combined with other observations
 - Link to ASD Observation Forms
- For Re-evaluations:
 - Review previous ASD testing and enter into eval report
 - Send and enter <u>Autism reassessment Parent Interview</u> and <u>Developmental</u> <u>History</u>
 - Give and enter Autism Reassessment Teacher Interview
 - One new Observation and one review Observation for ASD (These cannot be combined with any other observations)
- For ALL evaluations:
 - Enter needs for ASD in the needs section. There may not be a need in all three areas.
