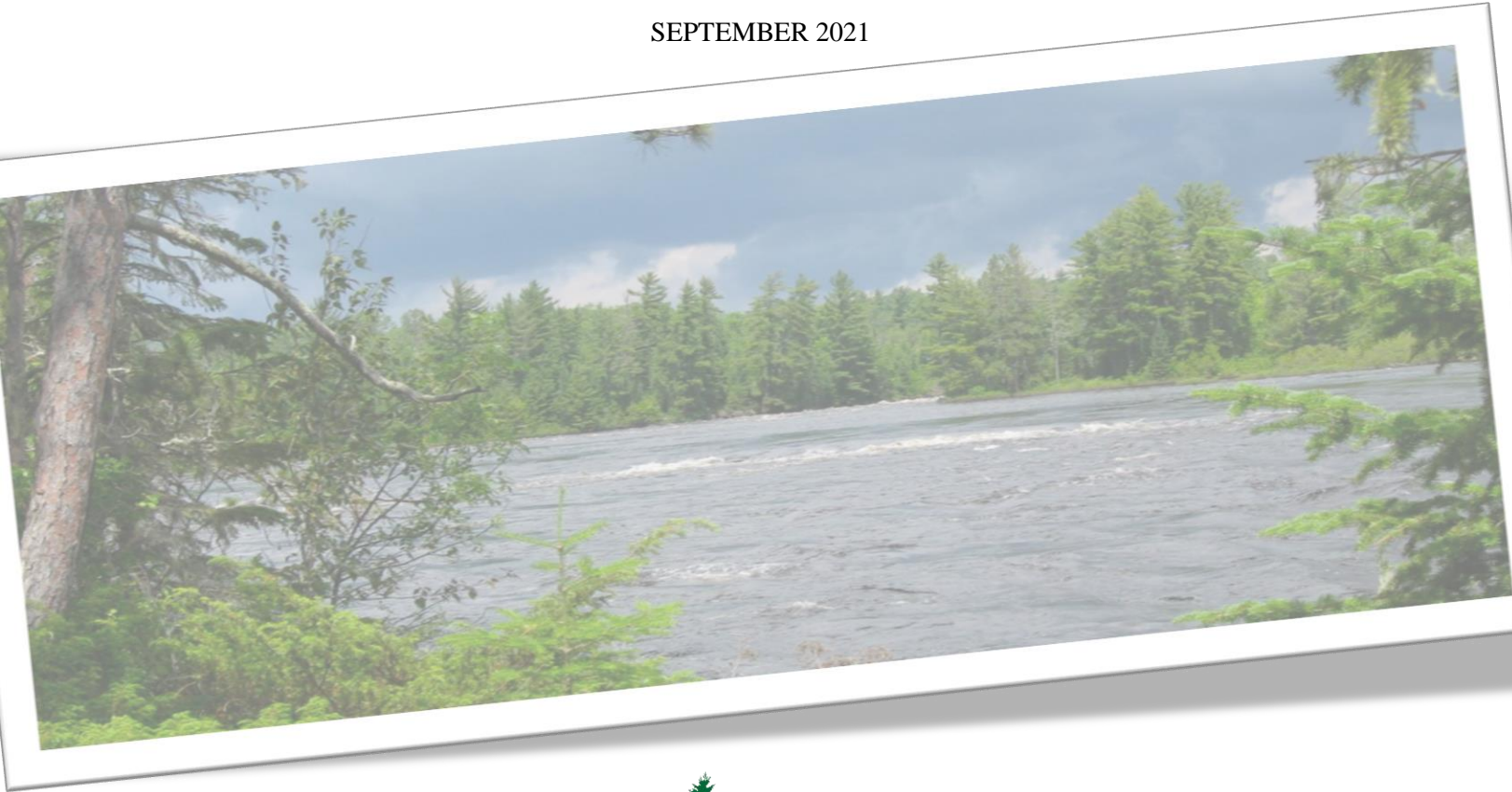

Did you know? When you enter an absence in Aesop it gets advertised to a pool of subs through TOC and the District? We share this pool of subs with other area districts. Enter leave as far in advance as possible, even months in advance, if you have it planned that far out. Entering pre-planned leave days in the system as early as possible, gives your absence a longer advertisement to subs, and greatly increases your chance of finding a sub to fill in.
