CARE FOR CHILDREN OF FAMILIES OF EMERGENCY WORKERS

- In the event that there is a school district closure due to the State's response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Southland School Age Care (SAC) childcare will be available to Southland students (age 4-12) who are children of full-time emergency workers from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM.
- Verification of employment will be required.
- The cost of childcare is free for all full-time emergency personnel during the closure.
- If needed, transportation is available for those families who qualify for emergency childcare.
