## **Southland Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes**

- 1. Call to Order Meeting started at 6:30pm
- 2. Staff Wish Lists
  - a. Teacher Request Via email due to time (Chrissy will show at meeting) See attachment.
  - b. VexIQ Robotics Tournament November 17<sup>th</sup> Southland MS/HS Paula S.- asking for volunteers for the tournament to assist wherever needed for the weekend. Help the day before, the day of and the day after for tear down. Rebel Nation will be doing the concession stands and they are asking for PTO to help as the money that they raise for this event will be donated to the PTO. There are 40 teams coming which means roughly 400 people will be attending.
  - c. Brian S. Asking the PTO to pay for the bussing to take elementary students and staff to the Homecoming Parade and back. Cost is \$150 round trip. Susan L motioned to approve request. Carrie S second. Request granted.

- 4. Treasurer's Report Total in the checking Acct is \$22,366.44 Right on with the bank! We will get \$3,976.87 back from all the supplies that were purchased. So we should be able to start the year with \$26,343.31!!
- 5. Referendum Update Michelle Nelsen Election Nov. 6<sup>th</sup> some townships will be mailed out their voting ballots. THIS IS YOUR WAY TO VOTE. There will not be voting places for all so if you get something in the mail (as you may have for the primary elections) please fill it out and mail it back in! Michelle went over flyer (Attached) and the updates they want to do and why. The 1st question is based on the following: Some of the concerns have been safety - science areas updated -playground area -lighting - roofing - fire code - electrical - H-Vac. System - Kitchen will be updated but not moved - Auditorium will stay the basically same with little things being done/no major renovations. The 2<sup>nd</sup> question will only pass if the 1<sup>st</sup> question passes – The question is to vote yes or no for adding/replacing a gym and trying to avoid using auditorium for gym, cutting programming and early morning/late night practices. This would be a 20 year bond. If the bond passes there will be time to update the MS/HS design and the School Board has the option to delay moving the Elementary Students over until construction is done to ease them into the transition. If the bond does fails the School Board DOES have the authority to spend some money and increase taxes to do things to accommodate to combination of schools but this option won't be the best learning environment for the kids. The will have to make partitions in the media center to make classrooms. Rose Creek School is closing for sure...If the bond fails keeping the Rose Creek School open will NOT be an option.

Michelle also reported that there will be 3 positions up for election for School Board members. Dave S. and Patti H. are not running again and Michelle's seat is up and she will be running again. There have been 7 candidates that have applied to run.

There will be 2 upcoming community meetings to tour and educate the public on the referendum. The first one will take place on Sept. 26 at 6:00 and the second one will be Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> 7:00. All meetings will be held at the MS/HS and consist of a short presentations/round table station discussions/Q&A's and tours (if needed).

- 6. Principal's Report We are having a wonderful start to the school year. The state testing came back and the students really rocked it and leading the pack. Feedback is needed on how parents thought the back to school conferences went. Those parents in attendance reported that the returning students it might not have been needed, but for incoming students and especially kindergarten it was good for them. Another parent reported it also depends on that returning student. Her child did benefit from it. It was suggested to have Brian send out a survey to ask parents what they thought. So keep an eye on the portal for that survey.


