I. NEW BUSINESS:

FINANCIAL PLAN:

- Based on enrollment projection for SY 2018-2019 of 1,389 students, Kalani will be allocated roughly 6 million.
- \$4,638 per student (break down 6 million)
- December 1st, 2017, elective fair and registration presentation for incoming 9th graders at Kaimuki Middle School.
- December 7, 2017, Kalani High School registration packet due date.
- Honolulu District allocates Special Education positions based on number of SPED students.
- Course offered to students are based on student interest.
- Draft Financial Plan possibly ready for SCC in January 2018
- Among department teachers, they “select” which classes they would (like) to teach
- Principal makes final decision in which teacher will teach which class
- By February/ March Otani needs to fill vacant position at Kalani.
- Financial Plan based on actual enrollment count at Kalani
- SCC approves Academic and Financial Plan about March/ April

- Suggestion for classes: Ceramics 3 to continue, Home Economics, Wood Shop/Metal Shop (Makers Club), After school credit program.
- Currently, Ken has a after school club (Marker Club) which students do hands on activities that benefit Kalani, the community and themselves. Is there a way students can earn a credit?
