Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Requirements

The device specifications identify the minimum system requirements, hardware and software specifications for student owned devices. The specifications are driven by network operations, the curricular objectives of our classes and the need for high productivity (including student research, problem solving, communication and collaboration) for the device. Cell phones will **NOT** be allowed access to the DOE network wifi.

Hardware Specification REQUIREMENTS

Device	MacBook or any PC laptop or chromebook or tablet
Operating System	OS 10.7 or higher / Windows 8.1 or 10
Processor	Dual core or better
Memory and RAM	64 GB storage or higher / 4 GB RAM or higher
Battery Life	4-6 hours or more (so device will last the school day without charging)
Wireless Capability	Yes

Software Specification REQUIREMENTS

AntiVirus Protection	Must be up to date and on a regular scan schedule. McAfee Antivirus, Norton Antivirus, AVG, Malwarebytes or equivalent
email	Students will be given / have a kalanihs.org account (gmail)
Web Browser	Google Chrome, Firefox, Safari or Internet Explorer (should have 2)

Additional RECOMMENDATIONS

Accessories	Protective case, head phones or ear buds, camera and microphone
Productivity Tools	Microsoft Office or Office 365, Google apps (sheets, docs, slideshow, etc.) and access to Google Classroom(s)
Storage	Cloud Storage (Google Drive, One Drive, etc.) or a flash drive (16 GB)
Other	Adobe Reader or equivalent Adobe Flash
