Kane Area School District has implemented the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) throughout the 2023/2024 school year.

## WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN?

He or she is eligible for <u>FREE BREAKFAST and FREE LUNCH</u> during the 2023-2024 school year. Your child/children can participate in school breakfast and school lunch with no fee and with no submission of an income eligibility application. **No further action is required by you!** 

## ALL MEALS MEET FEDERAL AND STATE GUIDELINES.

All meals will meet federal and state guidelines. Students must take 3 of the 4 items offered at breakfast, and one of those items must be a 1/2 cup fruit. For lunch, students must take 3 of the 5 items offered and one of those items must be a 1/2 cup fruit or vegetable.

## IS A LA CARTE INCLUDED?

Students who wish to purchase an extra entree, one of our snack options, or just milk must pay for these items. This program does not apply to a la carte items.

## **CONVENIENTLY MANAGE STUDENT ACCOUNTS.**

You can add funds to your student(s) account to purchase extra meal items and/or snacks as well as view previous a la carte purchases and receive low account balance notifications by setting up an online student meal account at *schoolcafe.com*.
