Kane Area School District families,

We have been notified of a positive student case of COVID-19 at Kane Area Middle School.

Through our contact tracing protocol, we have identified and notified all families whose students have had close contact with the individual who tested positive.

The student who has tested positive for COVID-19, and anyone who had close contact with the individual, will not return to the building for at least 14 days. If you have not been directly contacted by the school district, then your child has not been identified as a close contact. School will resume tomorrow for all other students and staff.

The primary symptoms of COVID-19 include shortness of breath, coughing, loss of taste or smell, and fever or chills. Other symptoms include congestion, sore throat, diarrhea, abdominal pain, and body aches. Anyone who needs medical care should call their healthcare provider to report an illness or exposure to someone with COVID-19 prior to seeking care. Please contact your student's school office if they begin to experience symptoms.
