The results help students interpret their strengths from the interest inventory and to identify areas where they may have an aptitude. March 8-May 5	MTAS Reading, Mathematics and Science	3-8 & 10-11	State assessment (State). The MTAS is an alternative assessment for those students with the most significant cognitive disabilities. [120-minutes]
March 8-May 13	MCA Science	5, 8 & 10	State assessment (State). Used to determine if students have mastered the state science standards. It is also used to determine quality of education provided by the school. [90-minutes]
