Why aren't meals free for the 22-23 school year? The USDA made it possible for school nutrition programs to serve all students free breakfast and lunch through "waivers". Congress did not extend these waivers for the 22-23 school year, so we will go back to regularly priced meals for <u>all students</u>. To see if you qualify to receive these benefits, you <u>must</u> fill out an application form and return it to the Elementary or High School office. - * A new application is needed **EVERY** school year.
- * Benefits from previous year expire October 17 without a new application.
- * Income cannot be listed as hourly or yearly. Gross income only (Weekly, Bi-Weekly, 2x-Month or Monthly).
- * You must provide the last 4 digits of your Social Security number.
- * You must sign and date the form.
- * If you answered **YES** to the assistance program, you **MUST** provide the case number.
