740 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE (DRONE) POLICY

For purposes of this policy, an unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), also known as a drone, is any aircraft without a human pilot aboard the device.

The use of a UAV is prohibited for any purpose by any person at Kingsland Public Schools during school hours and during any school sanctioned events occurring on school grounds. This prohibition applies to all fields of play, courts, arena, mats, gym floor or pool, and includes a ban on the entire facility, including the spectator areas and parking areas.

Kingsland Public Schools shall refuse admission or entry to anyone attempting to use a UAV; and if necessary, Kingsland Public Schools shall remove anyone attempting to use a UAV, confiscate the UAV, and/or report the incident to local law enforcement.

A request for policy exception by the superintendent must be in writing. The request must include compliance with state/federal regulations, scope of flyover, experience/training of operator and safety parameters. Requests are on a case-by-case basis with strict approval requirements.
