2022 Scholarship Criteria

Deadline: April 15, 2022. The Scholarship Selection Committee will meet after the deadline to choose one recipients from each school.

Criteria: All information submitted must be typed and mailed before the deadline.

1. Applicant should be pursuing a future in agriculture or a related field.
2. Applicant must be graduating in the spring of 2022 from a High School in Swift County.
3. Applicant must plan to enroll in two, three, or four-year post secondary education institution.
4. Applicant must provide a summary of education and career plans.
5. Applicant must provide a summary of community or school activities he/she has participated in.
6. Applicant must provide a letter of reference.
7. If awarded, recipient must submit their college transcripts upon completion of their first semester or quarter of college and must have achieved a GPA of 2.0 or better. The full scholarship will be sent upon receipt of this information.
