

LeRoy-Ostrander Public School has an enrollment of approximately 300 students in grades preK-12. The students are housed in one building. The building is separated into the main building that houses the high school and there is an elementary wing on the lower level. All students share the gym, music room, media center, commons, computer lab, and the swimming pool. Also on the school grounds there is an elementary playground, main football field, a practice field, and a baseball field.

LeRoy-Ostrander has committed to a one to one initiative with iPads and laptops. Students in grades 4 through 12 have individual devices and grades K-3 all have classroom sets of lpads. L-O has continued to keep up with the technology advances, not only with the devices but also with the infrastructure as we have 'black fiber' that is directly connected to the school which allows faster and more efficient use of the internet capacity.
