As we begin distance learning (grades 3-12) and hybrid learning (grades K-2) on Monday, November 23, 2020, we would like you to be aware of the following items:

--**Communication:** Please regularly check the school district website and the Infinite Campus Parent Portal for school district updates.

--**Food Service:** Beginning Monday, November 23, 2020 meal pick-ups will be available for those students in 3rd-12th grade that are distant learning. Pick-ups will be at the pool doors between the 11:00am - 11:45am. Please email Leann Drees (ldrees@leroy.k12.mn.us) or Nikki Bergen (nbergen@leroy.k12.mn.us) if you are interested. Deadline to do so is this Friday, November 20, 2020 as the kitchen needs a lunch count. Please note the menu is subject to change daily.

--**Internet Access:** The LeRoy Community Center and Ostrander Community Center will be available to those families with no internet or spotty internet. Please contact the office if you would like to utilize this service.

--**Student Attendance:** Grades 6-12 will follow daily schedule by logging on to Google Classroom (M, T, Th, F), grades 6-12 on Wednesday will have homeroom from 8:15-8:45am, 9-10:00am WIN Time, 12:30-1:30pm WIN Time, Grades 3-5 will follow teacher's correspondence through use of Google Classroom and Grades K-2 will be in-person/hybrid learning with an AM/PM schedule (teachers will be corresponding)

--**Activities:** Due to the recent Governor's Proclamation, athletic activities will be 'paused' from 11:59pm on Friday, November 20, 2020 through Friday, December 18, 2020. Community Education Classes are also 'paused'.
