

Event and Facilities Management Plan

Practice:

1. Players are not allowed to enter the school more than 10 minutes prior to practice start time.
2. Masks must be worn at all times while in the building including practice.
3. Players must sanitize their hands before/after practice and at each water break.
4. At the end of each practice, it is the players and coaches responsibility to sanitize all equipment before putting away.
5. Players must bring their own water bottles/towels to practice. No sharing of personal equipment is allowed.
6. Players will be in pods of 25 or less. It is encouraged to avoid changing pods day to day by athletes, and attendance for each practice will be taken daily and recorded. If players change pods during practice, coaches must document that on their attendance sheet.

Games:

1. Masks must be worn by all athletes, players, coaches, managers and essential workers at all times during the game and within the building.
2. Benches will be set up so each player is properly distanced on the bench. (staggering players on the bleachers)
3. Seating on the bench will be assigned, and they will sit at assigned seats each time they come out of the game.
4. Athletes will sanitize their hands each time they check in and out of the game.
5. The scorer's table and game ball will be sanitized before each game and at half-time. (second game ball at scorer's table to switch out during time-outs and sanitize)
6. It is encouraged to come to all games dressed and ready to play, but locker rooms can be used for changing and team meetings only. Please limit locker room time to 10 minutes or less.
7. Visiting JH teams will be allowed to stay and sit on the stage in chairs in the big gym to watch the varsity game.
8. All JH players & family members must exit the building immediately following the JH game. If there is a JV/V player in the same family, you still must exit the gym so custodians can sanitize in between games.

Spectators:

1. All spectators will be properly masked while in the building and respect social distancing. Any refusal to do so will result in your forfeiture to attend games in LeRoy.
 - Per conference-wide decision, only spectators from the home team fans will be allowed for the season.

- Spectators will be limited to two spectators (tickets) per family.
- Both spectators must be from the same household.
- Split families will be allowed two spectators from each household.
- Physical tickets will not be used. Each player can register for two tickets using a Google form. A link will be sent by email to families of players 2 days prior to each game. Registration will be taken until 1:00pm on the day of the game. **1:00 pm is a hard deadline. No exceptions will be made for late registration.**
- Attendance will be tallied on the sign in sheet and families will be billed \$5.00 for each fan registered in their name or who attends at the end of the season.
- When entering the building, you will tell the “ticket taker” your name and be directed to your assigned seat.
- Assigned seats will be determined by preference indicated upon sign up. Preference will be given to older students when determining seating charts.
- Spectators are expected to stay in their assigned seats.
- No concessions will be offered.

Game Responsibilities:

Custodians:

- Will put bleaches out
- Will set up scorers table, plugged in, Scoreboard on, Possession arrow set up
- Will put Sanitizer/Masks on scores table
- Will put side baskets up
- Will clean and Sanitize entire facility after sporting event has finished.

Athletic Director:

- Athletic Director role is to make sure everything runs smoothly and is there to provide support, answer questions, enforce rules, and make sure the spectators exit the facility in a timely manner after the event.
