

English Language Proficiency Assessments

ACCESS is an English language proficiency assessment based on the Minnesota Standards for English Language Development. This is a state-required English Language Proficiency assessment for all students identified as English Language Learners in grades K-12. There are four language domains assessed in the areas of reading, writing, listening, and speaking. Scores will be sent in Individual Student Reports (ISR) sent to the school district in August and given to parents during Back-to-school or fall conferences.
