Mr. Riebel's Report

Parents of Lewiston-Altura Elementary School,

In the classrooms and hallways throughout our school, you will see lots of bulletin boards, signs and posters that emphasize the Cardinal CARES. In addition to teaching and guiding students through lessons at their grade level academic topics, our staff work to teach and guide students in learning how to understand, show and live a set of social and emotional skills. CARES stand for Cooperation, Assertion, Responsibility, Empathy and Self-control. When developing and showing our Cardinal CARES, students are able to be a part of safe and respectful classrooms and school. I bring the idea of Cardinal CARES forward as part of the topic of this letter to parents. The CARES attributes will be needed from both students and parents in an endeavor that our elementary school is undertaking.

When the school district referendum and bond vote did not pass this fall, our school board directed administration to find ways to decrease the expenditures of our schools, both for this year and for future budgets. One of the needed recommendations that came forward was to eliminate the expenditures that come from the many field trips that our Elementary and High School students participate in each year. All field trips are to be eliminated unless fully funded by outside sources of revenue. Our Elementary School staff are looking to generate that source of revenue. We know that elementary students have routinely benefited from the experiences, learning and memories made from the various field trips. Whether it is to a local stop like a farm or our fire department, a regional state park, play performance, or museum, or the larger trips to Eagle Bluff Environmental Learning Center or the state capitol, we know that our students benefit from the experience of these trips. It is those field trip benefits that brings forth this letter.

### Lewiston-Altura Elementary School staff are announcing a fundraising effort.

We have set a goal of \$10,000. That amount of funds will cover the costs of the student registrations and travel costs of the '23-'24 field trips that have already been done and that are yet to come this spring. Any funds collected that go over this year's costs will go into the budget for '24-'25 school year field trips. Our last elementary fundraiser was in 2019. That fundraiser helped our elementary parent group, P.L.A.Y., generate over \$12,000. We are teaming with the same company from 2019 for this spring's fundraiser. Lewiston-Altura Elementary School has scheduled a fundraiser with:

### **Parenting Tip**

One day, my son returned from school and said, "Mommy, I couldn't show my project to everyone because **you** forgot to pack it."

Instead of reacting to his frustration, I took a deep breath and decided to use the situation as a teachable moment.

I explained to him that although I understood his feelings, **it was his responsibility** to ensure that he had everything he needed before leaving the house.

Together, we created a backpack checklist to help him remember all the necessary items for school. This simple exercise helped him learn the importance of personal accountability.

It's essential to teach children how to take responsibility for their actions and choices. This week's parenting guide "**Don't Let Your Child Grow Up With a Victim Mentality**" will help you do just that!

### DON'T LET YOUR CHILD GROW UP WITH A VICTIM MENTALITY

If you don't want your child **growing up with a victim mentality**, or thinking **life just happens to them**...

TEACH THEM PERSONAL ACCOUNTABILITY

• I'm in charge of my actions.

I'm responsible for my mistakes.

I can take control of my life.
 (A scary concept for many people.)



"I broke that." —

Mistakes happen AND we are **responsible for making amends and learning from them**.

### PERSONAL ACCOUNTABILITY MEANS NO EXCUSES.

"I pushed him BUT he didn't want to move."

Anything **after the BUT** is often an attempt to **avoid responsibility.** 

PERSONAL ACCOUNTABILITY MEANS ELIMINATING \*YOU\* STATEMENTS.

"YOU made me so angry."



There's no blaming others for our behavior and emotions. We take responsibility for both.

**Personal accountability** does NOT mean you aren't allowing your child to explain what happened. Your child explains what happened **WHILE taking responsibility for their actions**.

Tell your child — "Personal accountability is a superpower that can help you always be in charge of your life."

Start a culture of accountability in your family so your children have the skills they need to take ownership of their lives.

The Lewiston-Altura School Board invites you to join Members David Baer & Dave Pringle for a cup of coffee and conversation about the schools.





### September 2024 — May 2025

<u>Lewiston-Altura School Readiness</u> is a 4-Star Parent Aware rated preschool program that offers a play-inspired and educational learning environment for children ages 3 years old and up. Our Early Childhood Licensed Teachers plan daily education and care activities based on the accredited Creative Curriculum while supporting and engaging the children to develop confidence in learning while having fun and making new friends.

We provide:

- Quality, seamless, developmentally appropriate education and care 7am-5:00 pm
- New extended-day programming will provide quality developmentally appropriate activities and care designed to support families and children.

School District Transportation may be available for children who are ages 4 and up.

The preschool schedule follows the district calendar for holidays and weather related closings. Full day programming may be offered on no school days and is included in the monthly fee.

**Class options:** 

Full care is a half day of preschool and half day of Cardinal Club care

Children ages 4 and 5, entering Kindergarten in Fall 2025 \*Preference is given children enrolling in full care

> 3x/ week afternoons only (\$120/month) 5x/week - mornings or afternoons (\$200/month) 5x/week-full days (\$280/month)

Children ages 3 and 4, entering Kindergarten in Fall 2026 \*Preference is given to children enrolling in full care

Families will be notified around April 15th of their child's placement.

Additional care from 7-8:30am and 3-5:00pm maybe available in the Cardinal Club program for an additional fee.

We administer only personal prescriptions filled by a pharmacist, with a physician's label, bearing the child's name and directions for administration. Over the counter medications (Tylenol, Advil, Ibuprofen, etc.) must be in the original container labeled for that medication. The parent must give medication to staff along with completed "Authorization for Giving Medication in Schools" form (physician signature required for prescriptions) which can be picked up at Cardinal Club or main office and is also available on the Lewiston-Altura District website. Over the counter medicines taken longer than 2 weeks require a physician's signature.

#### Immunizations

A copy of a child's immunizations or an applicable exemption is required to be on file before a child's first attendance day. Be sure to update your immunization form as needed.

#### Sunscreen (summer only)

Cardinal Club will provide sunscreen, or if you prefer to purchase sunscreen for your child, sunscreen must be labeled with child's name and turned into Cardinal Club staff. Children are not allowed to carry sunscreen in their backpacks. Staff will distribute sunscreen and remind students when to apply and reapply.

### School Readiness Preschool and CARDINAL CLUB Agreement

- 1. I understand that I am responsible for payments of tuition and fees. A statement will be provided upon request.
- 2. I agree to pay for services with the rates as stated in the parent handbook. There will be a \$30.00 charge for all returned checks as a result of non-sufficient funds.
- 3. I understand that center hours are 7:00 am to 5:00p.m. I agree to pay a late fee of \$10.00 beginning at 5:05 p.m. This will be added to my bill. I will notify staff if I am running late as a courtesy. The phone number is 522-3245 for before and after school care.
- 4. I agree to supply the coordinator with a monthly schedule of our need for the program when applicable. (See handbook) Paper calendars are available for my convenience and will be emailed to me when ready. *Children enrolled in Preschool only do not need to submit a calendar*.
- 5. I understand that payment is required monthly. Calendars and/or payment are due by the first day of the month. If I am unable to pay at the time the payment is due, I will contact the director and we will determine a written pay schedule. There will be **no refunds** for failure to show, sickness, vacations, or changes in schedule. If the school or program closes due to weather or other emergencies, refunds will not be given. Adding my child for a day not already scheduled, <u>may be possible when called in a day in advance depending on center activities.</u>
- 6. I understand that the program reserves the right to close for any reason. Parents and guardians will be notified in advance.
- 7. I agree to notify the staff if anyone else will be picking up my child on a particular day.
- 8. I agree to pay a registration or activity fee (when applicable) that can be applied towards activities, new supplies, and/or equipment.
