•	Conscientious exemption: No student is required to have an immunization, which is contrary to the conscient teld beliefs of his/her parent or guardian. To receive this exemption, a parent or legal guardian must complete sign the following statement and have it notarized.

Special Exceptions for DTP, Td, and Polio

Children less than 7 years of age: The 5th dose of DtaP/DTP/DT (similarly the 4th dose of polio vaccine) is not necessary if the 4th DtaP/DTP/DT (3rd dose of polio) was administered after the 4th birthday.

Children 7 years of age and older: A history of 3 doses of DtaP/DTP/Td and 3 doses of polio vaccine meets the minimum requirements of the law.

Students in grades 7 – 12: A Td booster given at age 11 or later is not required for students in grades 7 - 12 whose most recent Td was given after their 7^{th} birthday but before their 11^{th} birthday. Instead, it will be required 10 years after the date of the most recent dose.
