


If You Test Positive For COVID:

Stay home for 10 days from symptom start date or positive test date (if asymptomatic)

OR

Shortened quarantine:

- Stay home and Isolate for 5 days
- Get tested with an At Home Antigen Test on Day 5 – If negative (email proof to school nurse) – You may return to school WITH a mask on Day 6 through Day 10
- If Positive you must remain out of school through Day 10 and can return on Day 11.
- If you still have a fever on Day 5 you must stay out through Day 10 and can return on Day 11.
- If family is choosing a shortened quarantine, they must wear a properly fitting mask for days 6-10. If student is found to not be wearing mask properly (over nose & mouth) they will be sent home & must remain at home through day 10.



Close Contact Within the Home:

- Close contact can come to school with a mask. Mask must be worn properly (over mouth & nose) for 14 days from household symptom start date or positive test date. If a student is in school and develops 1 or more common symptom or 2 or less common symptoms (from Minnesota Department of Health decision tree) they will be sent home for 10 days from date symptoms develop.

Close Contacts within the school:

- Email will be sent out to parents that students were in close contact with a positive case at school. Please monitor your child for signs or symptoms of Covid-19. IF a child develops signs or symptoms, please keep them home to quarantine for 10 days (or 5 if doing the steps for a shortened quarantine) or test for Covid-19.
