



Lyle Safe Return to School Learning Plan

Public Comment Summary June 21, 2021

On June 11, 2021, Lyle Public School (LPS) sent an email to staff and parents requesting Public Comment on the most recent Safe Return to School Learning Plan. This request was also posted on our District website and Facebook pages, including a survey where stakeholders can offer their comments. This was posted until June 21st, where the information was collected for this summary.

We had a total 15 comments during the 10-day comment period. Of this 15, eight of them were parents and seven were staff members. No students nor community members made comments.

A statement suggesting the “Safe Learning Plan” establishes a safe environment for students and staff?” was found to be positive. 11 strongly agreed while four agreed. There were no disagrees or strongly disagrees.

A statement suggesting the “Safe Learning Plan” establishes a supportive environment for students and staff?” was also found to be positive. 10 strongly agreed while five agreed. There were no disagrees or strongly disagrees.

When asked about what was missing, the only questions were about the availability of vaccinations and about our building’s ventilation.

The final survey question asked for comments on our plan. The overwhelming majority of statements suggested we not require any masks on our buses and vans.

Lyle Public School wishes to thank those who provided input to our plan. We will continue to monitor state and federal updates to provide the safest environment for our students, staff, and community members.
