1. Applicant must be a graduating senior of Lyle Public School who intends to further his/her education.
2. Student must have a "C" or better average.
3. The applicant may use this scholarship for expenses at any four year college, Community College, Vocational College or Business College.
4. The student must be in good standing in the school and community.
5. Payments will be made to LHS on behalf of the recipient after he/she completes registration at their post secondary institution.
6. Application must be returned to the school office by May 1st each year.
7. If the scholarship is not used by December 31 of the recipient's high school graduation year, the scholarship shall be null and void.
8. The Lyle Liquor Scholarship Committee will have the final decision on awarding the scholarship.
