National Honor Society

Election to membership in the National Honor Society represents the highest honor and trust that can be bestowed upon a student in the junior or senior year of high school. The National Honor Society recognizes students for outstanding SCHOLARSHIP, CHARACTER, LEADERSHIP, and SERVICE. Membership in the society is indicative that the student has attained and is demonstrating and promoting all of these qualities, and is exerting an effort to improve conditions in the school and community.

Meeting the grade point average requirement of 3.5 is not the sole criteria for acceptance into the National Honor Society. Schools that select members solely on the basis of scholarship are placing their charters in jeopardy for it violates the Constitution of the NHS. Evidence that you meet the qualifications of SCHOLARSHIP, CHARACTER, LEADERSHIP, and SERVICE requirements are necessary to be eligible for membership.

Membership

Membership in the Mabel-Canton chapter is an honor bestowed upon a student. Selection for membership is by a faculty council and is based on outstanding SCHOLARSHIP, CHARACTER, LEADERSHIP, and SERVICE. Once selected, members have the responsibility to continue to demonstrate these qualities. Members who resign or are dismissed are never again eligible for its benefits.

Selection of Members

- 1. To be eligible for membership, the candidate must be a member of the junior or senior class. Candidates must have been in attendance at the school for the equivalent of one semester.
- 2. The selection of members to the chapter shall be by a majority vote of the faculty council. Anyone applying for membership with an honor code violation will not be considered for acceptance. If at any time, the Minnesota State High School League rules are broken, the student will be dismissed from NHS.
- 3. Faculty and staff will review the applicants' names. Students who do not promote academics, service, leadership and character in the classroom will not be considered for membership.

Application Deadline

All STUDENT FORMS must be turned in no later than <u>Friday, April 21th at 3:15 p.m. to Ms. Hahn-Miller or Ms. Hollar.</u>

CANDIDATE FORMS will not be processed unless the following are turned in completed at the same time: all forms; ALL appropriate signatures. If you plan to be out of town on this day, make arrangements to get them turned in early.

The student who exercises LEADERSHIP:

- Is resourceful in proposing new problems, applying principles, and making suggestions
- Demonstrates leadership in promoting school activities
- Exercises influence on peers in upholding school ideals
- Contributes ideas that improve the civic life of the school
- Is able to delegate responsibilities
- Exemplifies positive attitudes
- Inspires positive behavior in others
- Demonstrates academic initiative
- Successfully holds school offices or positions of responsibilities, conducting business efficiently and effectively, and without prodding, demonstrates reliability and dependability
- Follows the Minnesota State High School League rules

The student who SERVES:

- Is willing to uphold scholarship and maintain a loyal school attitude
- Participates in some outside activity (examples: girl scouts, boy scouts, church groups, volunteer service for the aged, poor or disadvantaged, family duties, etc.)
- Volunteers dependable and well-organized assistance, is gladly available, and is willing to sacrifice to offer assistance
- Works well with others and is willing to take on difficult or inconspicuous responsibilities
- Cheerfully and enthusiastically renders any requested service to the school
- Is willing to represent the class or school in inter-class and inter-scholastic competition
- Does committee and staff work without complaining
- Shows courtesy by assisting visitors, teachers, and students

The student of CHARACTER:

- Takes criticism willingly and accepts recommendation graciously
- Consistently exemplifies desirable qualities or behavior (cheerfulness, friendliness, poise, and stability)
- Upholds principles of morality and ethics
- Cooperates by complying with school regulations concerning property, programs, office, halls, etc.
- Demonstrates the highest standards of honesty and reliability
- Shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others
- Observes instruction and rules, punctuality, and faithfulness both inside and outside of the classroom
- Has powers of concentration and sustained attention as shown by perseverance and application to studies
- Maintains truthfulness in acknowledging obedience to rules, avoiding cheating in written work, and showing unwillingness, to profit by the mistakes of others
- Actively helps to rid the school of bad influences or environment
