Hello Medford School Families, Our staff has spent the past few days organizing and preparing for the mandatory closure. We have models and schedules tentatively in place as required by the Governor and then some. Please read through each number as there is something for everyone. #1 Daycare begins tomorrow (Tuesday). The schedule is 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This daycare is for children of emergency personnel only. Breakfast, lunch and a snack will be provided. Please register TODAY by calling the community education office at 214-6304. Please escort your child or children to the front door (elementary) when you arrive. Further details are available by calling the community education office as there are qualifications required to use this service. #2 Our food service program will be providing food twice a day for ALL Medford students. The times are 7:00-9:00 a.m. and then again from 4:00-6:00 p.m. Breakfast and lunch items (sack lunch) will be provided during these times. A food service worker will meet students/families at the main high school doors. Students will use their student identification numbers to get their meals, just like they would when school is in session. This is a pick-up system only as the doors will be locked and no students will enter the building. Please do not drop your student off. We need this system to be fluid without people congregating. #3 E-Learning will begin on March 30th. High school students (Grades 6-12) know what this entails as we will continue to use our interactive models and platforms to communicate with students. The elementary looks a little different. Grades 3-4 will be bringing their devices home and grades K-2 will have resources and packets made available. Details on e-learning will come from the building principals. Again, e-learning will begin on March 30th. #4 Tomorrow (Tuesday) will be used as a pick up supplies day. Parents (elem) and student or parents (high school) are encouraged to come and get your child's supplies. Staff have organized materials for quick and easy pick up. This includes books, crayon boxes, devices and other academic essentials. PARENTS of elementary students can come to the elementary doors. No elementary students will be allowed to enter. You will be escorted to your child's room to pick up materials and then escorted back to the exit. Students (parent optional) in grades 7-12 should come to the main high school doors. Much like the elementary, students or parents will be escorted to their lockers to get any needed supplies and then escorted back to the exit. The difference in the pickup process is based on high school parents most likely NOT knowing locker locations and lock combinations. The window for pick up is 6:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. TUESDAY MARCH 17th I ask that you check emails on a regular basis as more detailed messages will be coming.
