Medford Public School #763 Enrollment Cap Standards

The following enrollment cap standards will be used when determining enrollment options and class sizes. Policy 509: Enrollment of Nonresident Students, and all applicable MN Statutes will be followed. If Enrollment Option requests exceed the number of available seats at a specific grade level by the January 15 deadline, a lottery will be held to determine enrollment status.

Enrollment Caps:

Kindergarten

Enrollment through the Enrollment Options Program and/or Non-Resident Agreement will close when enrollment for Kindergarten reaches 69 students. Enrollment may rise above 69 students if additional resident students are enrolled after the cap is reached.

Grades 1-3

Enrollment through the Enrollment Options Program and/or Non-Resident Agreement will close when enrollment for Grades 1-3 reaches 75 students. Enrollment may rise above 75 students if additional resident students are enrolled after the cap is reached.

Grades 4-12

Enrollment through the Enrollment Options Program and/or Non-Resident Agreement will close when enrollment for Grades 4-12 reaches 81 students. Enrollment may rise above 81 students if additional resident students are enrolled after the cap is reached.

Lottery method:

If non-resident applications received by January 15 put any grade level above the caps listed above, an impartial lottery will be held by random drawing of the non-resident applications for that grade level. Siblings of currently enrolled students and applications related to an approved integration and achievement plan must receive priority in the lottery.
