## **Community Education Scholarships**

Purpose -- The scholarship is designed to allow people living in the Medford School District #763, who wish to participate in Community Education activities, the ability to do so without financial hardship. Thus, the scholarship enables donors to contribute gifts to endow the fund to fulfill this purpose.

- 1. The application form is below. This form needs to be completed and returned to the Community Education Office at least 2 weeks prior to the class offering date.
- 2. Persons applying for the scholarship money must meet certain criteria in order to qualify. Applicants may qualify for scholarship monies if they are eligible for any of the following assistance programs;
  - Free or reduced lunch programs
  - Recipients of Supplemental Security Income (SSI) Social Security Benefits
  - Medical Assistance Program
  - Other (explanation to be provided)
- 3. Scholarship amounts given per request will be a maximum of \$30 per person. Minimum fee of 25% of the program costs is required from the person(s) accepting scholarship monies. One scholarship per person, per booklet may be awarded.
- 4. Only the Medford Community Education Coordinator will review the application forms in order to maintain strict confidentiality.

- 5. Applicants will be notified before the class begins whether or not their scholarship monies have been granted. This will be done in a timely manner.
- 6. Anyone being approved to receive scholarship monies must bring their approval letter when registering for the class or when sending registration to confirm his/her class participation.
- 7. Medford Community Education reserves the right to verify all information contained on the application form in order to either grant, deny, or revoke any scholarship monies.
- 8. Medford Community Education admits students of any race, color, national, religious, or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national, religious, or ethnic origin in administration of its education policies, admission policies, or scholarships.
- 9. Funding for the scholarship monies come from associations, private donations, and memorials. Any person wishing to contribute to this fund may obtain information from the Medford Community Education Coordinator.
- 10. Scholarship monies will not be applicable to all courses. Please inquire at time of application.
