PSEO requirements: Minimum cumulative GPA for juniors is 3.0, minimum cumulative GPA for seniors is 2.5 Some courses require multiple measures requirements.

For MI-B High School juniors and seniors planning to earn their required high school credits through PSEO, the following is enforced:

- Students must fulfill high school graduation requirements. Communication with college PSEO advisor and high school counselor regarding course registration is strongly encouraged
- A PSEO student will receive an 'F' on their high school transcript for withdrawing from a college course.
- No credit will be given for PSEO courses that are near equivalent to those already completed at or enrolled in the high school.
- PSEO students must complete a minimum of six high school credits annually.
- MI-B is not responsible for providing transportation or tracking attendance for PSEO students.
- PSEO students may not be on MI-B campus during the school day unless they are enrolled in a high school course or there is a special event.

## College in the Schools

College in the Schools is another PSEO option in which Minnesota North partners with Mt. Iron-Buhl to provide college-level courses at the high school. Participation in College in the Schools (CIS) courses allows high-achieving students the opportunity for challenging coursework while remaining with their peer group at the high school.

CIS requirements: Minimum cumulative GPA for juniors is 3.0, minimum cumulative GPA for seniors is 2.5
