

#### **COVID-19 EXCLUSION GUIDANCE**

#### Decision Tree for Symptomatic Individuals in Schools & Childcare Programs

Send home or deny entry if **ANY** of the following symptoms are present: **fever (100.4°F or higher)**; **new onset or worsening cough**; **or shortness of breath** 

## Has the person been clinically evaluated?

Lab confirmed COVID-19 <sup>c</sup>

MDH will provide instructions to the individual & household contacts about when it is safe to return to work/school

## Has the person been clinically evaluated?

Clinically diagnosed COVID-19 \*c

Stay home at least 7 days or for 3 days with no fever & improvement of respiratory symptoms – whichever is longer.

## Has the person been clinically evaluated?

Alternate clinical diagnosis or laboratory confirmed condition (e.g., norovirus, hand/foot/mouth) <sup>d</sup>

Follow provider directions/ recommended treatment & return guidance

# For a person not clinically evaluated who is monitoring symptoms at home

If ANY of the following symptoms: fever, new onset or worsening cough; or shortness of breath \*c

Stay home at least 7 days or for 3 days with no fever & improvement of respiratory symptoms – whichever is longer.

For a person not clinically evaluated who is monitoring symptoms at home

Other symptoms not consistent with COVID-19 (diarrhea, vomiting, rash only) d
