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Baseball Field- Board member Jason Gellerstedt shared a plan to improve the baseball field. We will move forward to secure the plan so we can implement it right after the next baseball season.

Strategic Planning- Edie Carr provided a presentation in regard to our strategic planning process. The board needs to come to the next Working Session with one person who can commit to be a part of this process. It will take one meeting a month for about seven months. We will also need 3-4 staff members to participate.

Board Member Reports: Director Tiedeman mentioned she likes the student council reports and hearing about all the good things going on with our students and sports teams. Clerk Bainter acknowledged Susan Johnson's years of service and wished her well in retirement, and also mentioned the technology committee met to address the needs that are transforming with students and technology.
