Shall the School Board of Independent School District No. 912 (Milaca), Minnesota, be authorized to issue general obligation school building bonds in an amount not to exceed \$33,385,000, for acquisition and betterment of school sites and facilities, including vocational education & building trades space, various deferred maintenance projects inclusive of roofing, pool, windows and security, a performing arts center, and a field house with community exercise and meeting space?
