



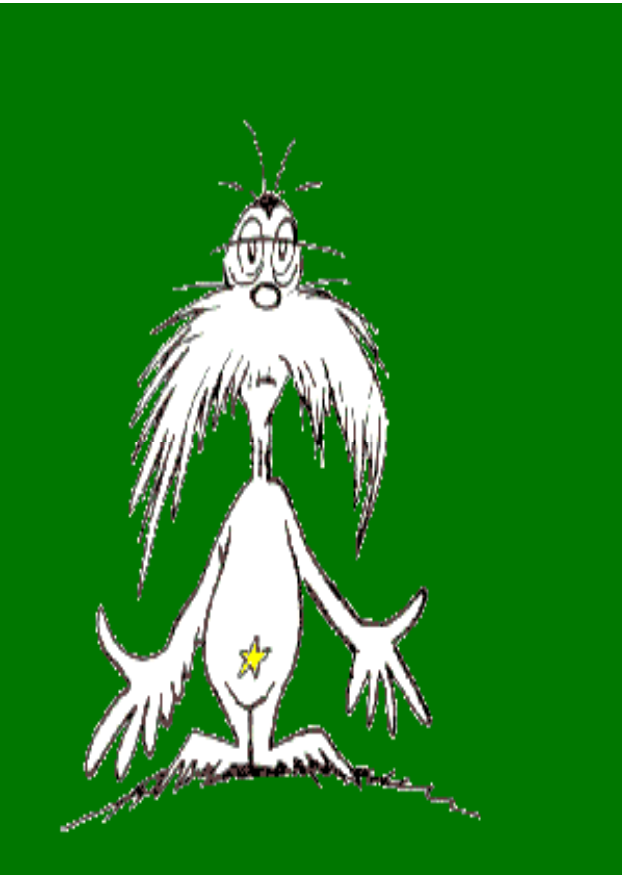

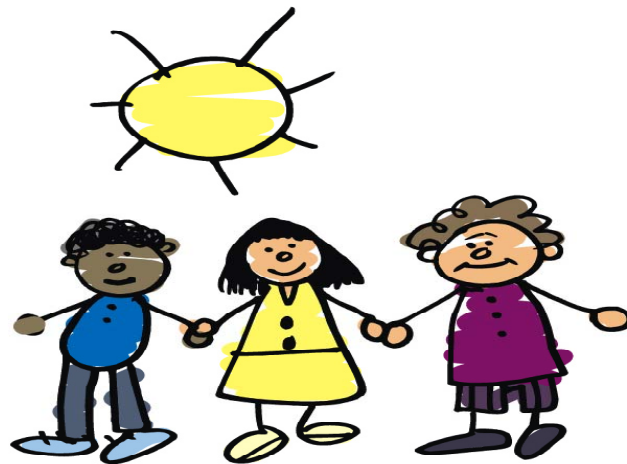

# Current KinderPlus Enrollment

- 39 children enrolled
  - Full Pay: 24 kids = \$ 260/month (61%)
  - Reduced: 7 kids = \$ 150/month (18%)
  - Free: 8 kids = \$65/month (21%)



# Current All Day Every Other Day Enrollment



- Mrs. Anderson = 19 red / 18 blue
- Mrs. Becker = 18 red / 19 blue
- Mrs. Lyrenmann = 19 red / 18 blue
- Ms. Thomas = 19 red

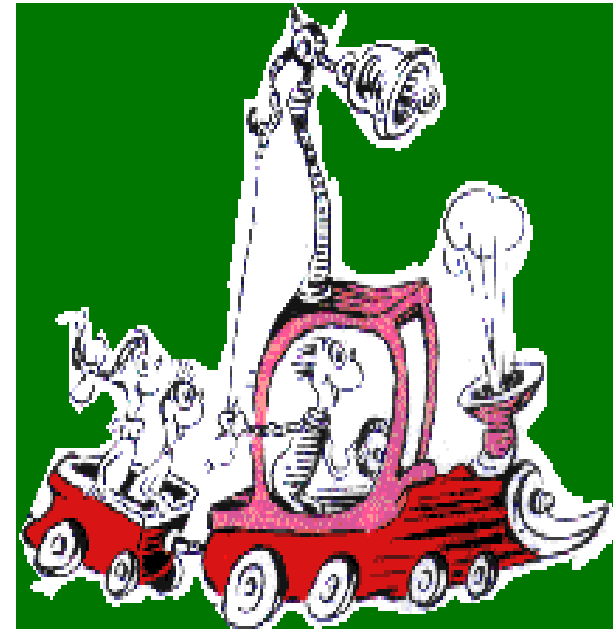
# KinderPlus Schedule

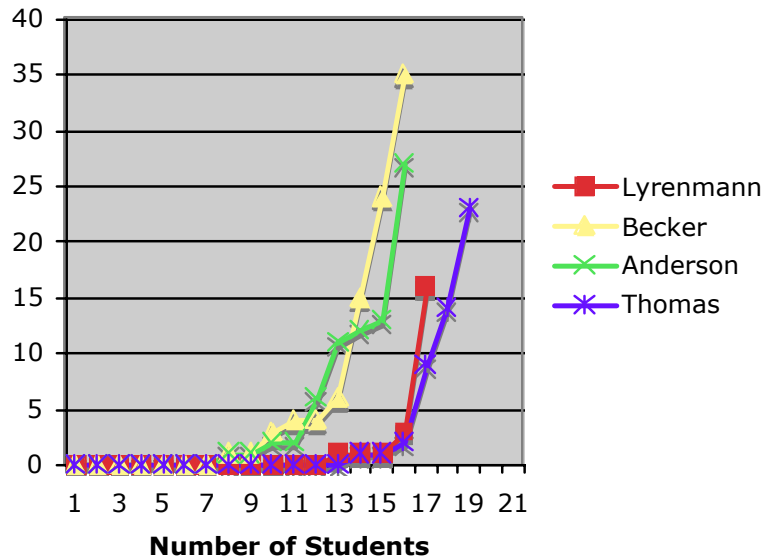

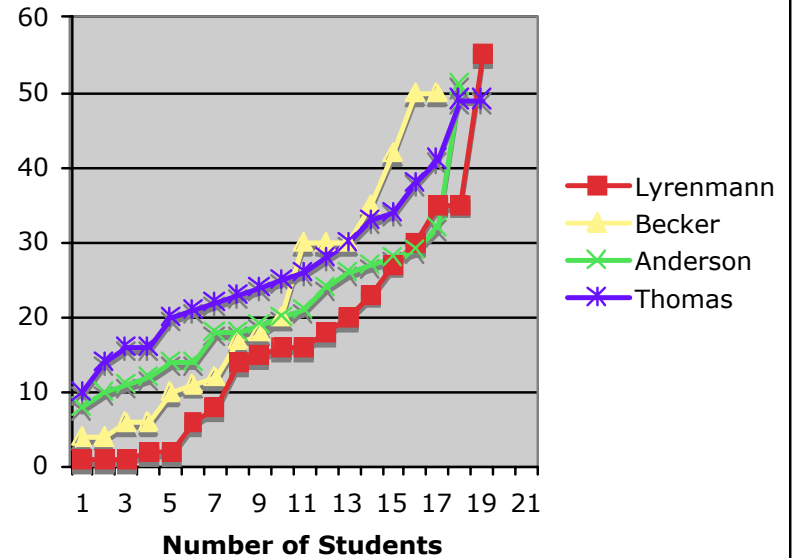
## One Minute Timed

### Red January Letter Sounds



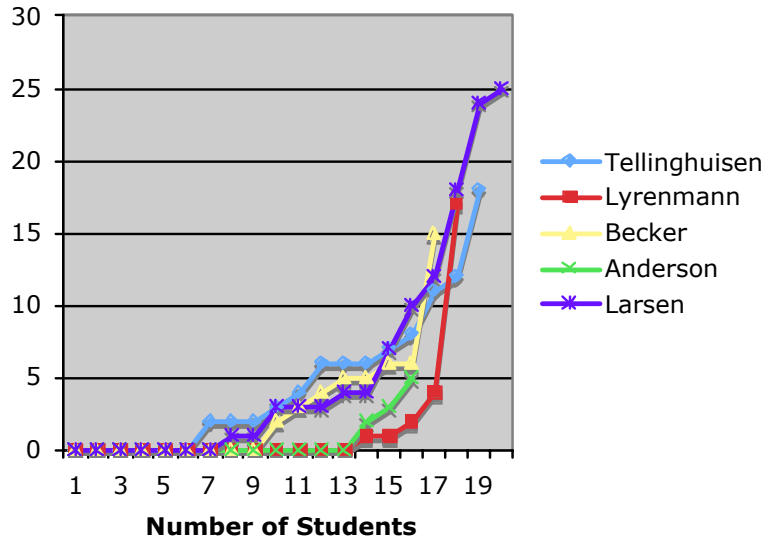

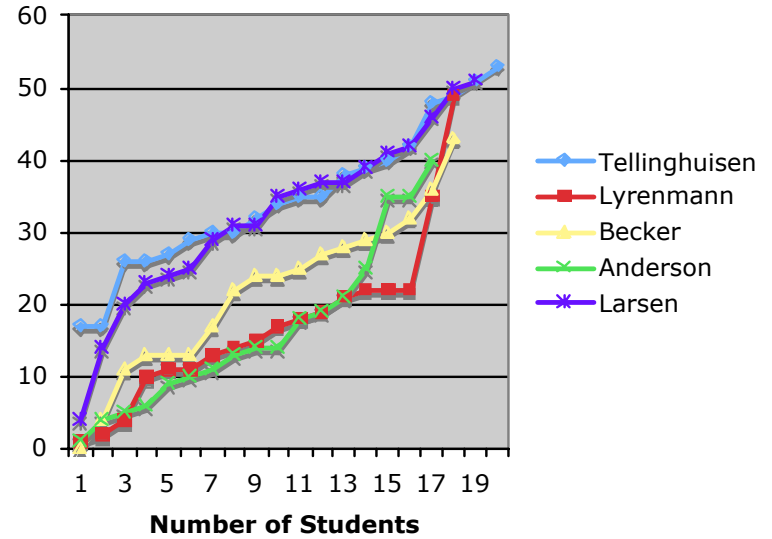

### Blue January Letter Sounds

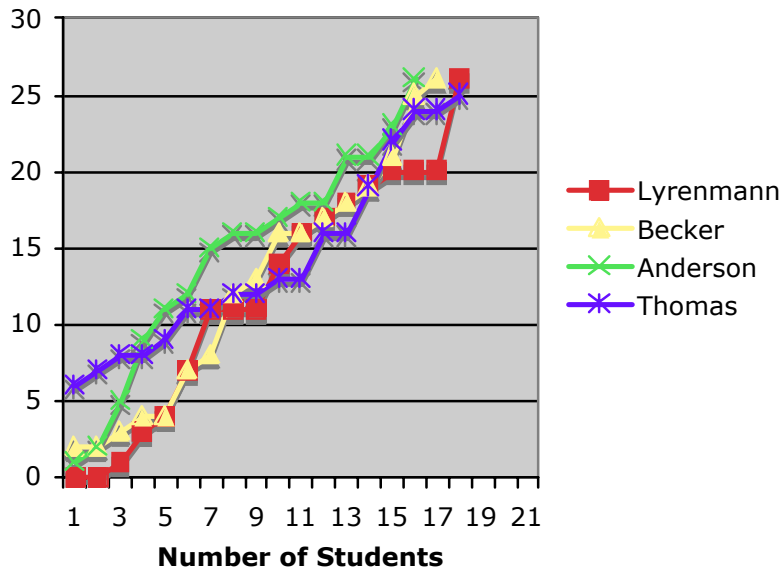




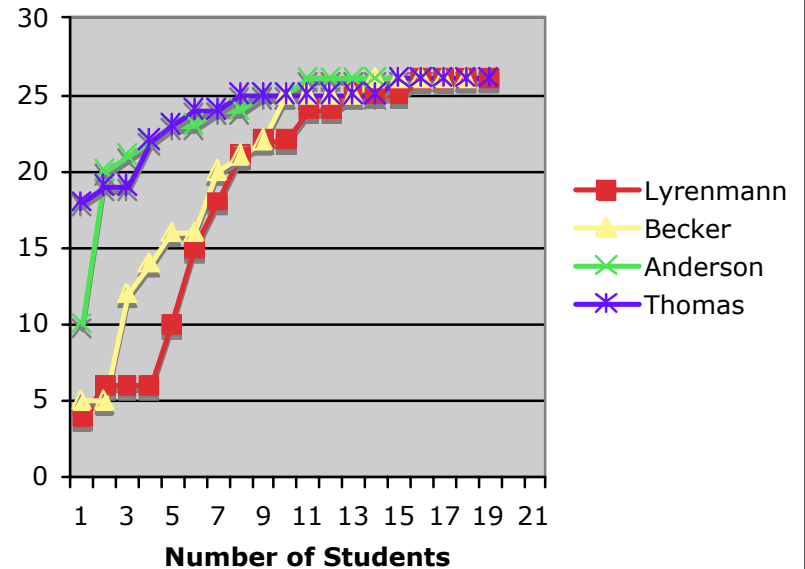
