

Current KinderPlus Enrollment

- 39 children enrolled
 - Full Pay: 24 kids = \$ 260/month (61%)
 - Reduced: 7 kids = \$ 150/month (18%)
 - Free: 8 kids = \$65/month (21%)

- Ms. Thomas = 19 red



Letter Sounds Graph One Minute Timed











Letter Sounds Graph One Minute Timed












Letter Sound Graphs Not Timed









